Personal data include common data and will be processed for the purposes related to the management of the complaint/request and the out-of-court settlement of the dispute indicated in this form through the Conciliation Procedure and their provision is mandatory. The legal basis for the processing is consent, pursuant to art. 6(1)(a) of the GDPR.

Personal data will be processed, in compliance with the regulations in force, through manual, IT and telematic tools and by implementing procedures strictly related to the aforementioned purposes, so as to ensure the confidentiality and security of the data.
