

Privacy Notice on the Processing of Personal Data Provided by Users for Submitting Reports Related to the Company's "Accessibility of IT Tools"

Privacy Policy pursuant to article 13 of the European Regulation 2016/679

In accordance with the legislation in force on data protection (Art. 13 of European Regulation 2016/679 – "GDPR"), Autostrade per l'Italia S.p.A. (hereinafter also referred to as the "Company") hereby provides the following information on the processing of personal data supplied by Users for the purpose of submitting reports concerning the accessibility of the Company's IT tools, in accordance with Law No. 4 of 9 January 2004 and the AgID Guidelines on the accessibility of IT tools, through the dedicated email address: segnalazioniaccessibilita.aspi@autostrade.it.

1. DATA CONTROLLER

Autostrade per l'Italia S.p.A. with registered office in Via A. Bergamini, 50 - 00159 Rome.

For this purpose, the Data Protection Officer (DPO) of Autostrade per l'Italia S.p.A. is located at the registered office of the data controller.

2. CATEGORIES OF PROCESSED DATA

The personal data processed by the Controller include "general" personal data (name, surname, e-mail address).

The data controller will not process data that are not strictly necessary for the purposes mentioned in point 3, even if they have been provided voluntarily by users.

3. PURPOSES AND LEGAL BASIS FOR PROCESSING

The User's personal data will be processed by Autostrade per l'Italia S.p.A. solely for purposes related and/or functional to the collection and management of the Report.

Also in compliance with the principle of data minimization, Users are requested not to include in the body of the email any additional personal data (such as, in particular, data relating to health status) and/or redundant and/or unnecessary information with respect to the purposes indicated above; in such cases, the Data Controller will refrain from using such data/information.

The legal basis for the processing is the "legal obligation" pursuant to Article 6(1)(c) of the GDPR.

4. METHODS OF PROCESSING

The data are processed in compliance with the regulations in force, using IT and telematics tools, with a processing strictly geared to the purposes indicated, in order to guarantee the security and confidentiality of the data.

5. DATA RETENTION PERIODS

Personal Data will be retained only for the time strictly necessary to achieve the purposes for which it was collected, in compliance with the principle of data minimisation set out in Article 5(1)(c) of the GDPR.

In particular, with regard to the purposes of the processing, common personal data relating to reports concerning the accessibility of the Company's IT systems will be retained for a period of 24 months from the date of collection.

6. DATA RECIPIENTS

Within Autostrade per l'Italia S.p.A., the personal data provided may be communicated only to those people who have been appointed by the Data Controller to process the data and who are authorised to carry out the processing operations in the context of the above-mentioned activities.

The aforementioned data may be disclosed to third parties (participating parent/subsidiary companies or third-party companies) who are necessary for the processing of the data for the purposes mentioned in point 3 and who are appointed as "data processors" for this purpose in accordance with Article 28 of the GDPR.

The full list of people designated as Data Processors is available from the DPO.

Under no circumstances will personal data be disclosed.

7. DATA TRANSFERS OUTSIDE THE EUROPEAN UNION

Personal data will not be transferred to countries outside the European Union. In the event that data is transferred outside the European Union, the data controller will ensure that the existence of a European Commission adequacy decision is verified or appropriate data protection clauses will be agreed with any third party recipients.

8. RIGHTS OF DATA SUBJECTS

To conclude, it should be noted that Articles 15-22 GDPR allow data subjects to exercise specific rights. In particular, the data subject may request from the data controller access, rectification, erasure, restriction of processing, withdrawal of consent and portability of the data concerning him or her. The data subject also has the right to object to the processing. If the right to object is exercised, the data controller reserves the right not to process the request and thus to continue the processing if there are compelling legitimate grounds to proceed with the processing that prevail over the interests, rights and freedoms of the data subject.

The above rights may be exercised by sending a request to the Data Protection Officer (DPO) at the following PEC address: dpo@pec.autostrade.it, using the forms provided by the data controller on the website www.autostrade.it.

The data subject may lodge a complaint with the Italian Data Protection Authority pursuant to Article 57(f) of the GDPR.
