## INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 13 OF EUROPEAN REGULATION NO. 679/2016 ("GDPR")

Pursuant to Article 13 of European Regulation 2016/679 (GDPR), Autostrade per l'Italia SpA - with registered office in via A. Bergamini, 50, 00159 Rome - as Data Controller, hereby informs that the personal data of the persons (legal representative and/or attorney and/or Company contact person) requesting the issue or renewal of authorisation for the installation of operating signs visible from the motorway network under its jurisdiction, pursuant to Article 23.7 of the Highway Code, are processed solely for the purposes of managing the requests, preliminary investigation and issue of the authorisation.

## 1. NATURE OF THE DATA PROCESSED AND PURPOSE OF PROCESSING

This data includes personal data (first name, last name, residence) and contact data (email address, telephone number) of the aforementioned persons ('Data Subjects') and is processed in execution of pre-contractual measures taken at the request of the Data Subjects themselves and in fulfilment of a legal obligation (Highway Code), pursuant to Art. 6.1, letter b) and letter c) GDPR respectively, with logic strictly related to the aforementioned purpose, so as to guarantee the security and confidentiality of the data.

## 2. METHODS OF PROCESSING - RETENTION PERIODS

The data will be stored - in servers located in Italy or within the European Union - only for the time necessary for the aforementioned purposes for which they are collected, in compliance with the principle of minimisation pursuant to Art. 5.1.c) GDPR.

These data may be communicated to third parties and/or competent Authorities and/or public administrative bodies, entitled to request them in the cases provided for by the relevant legislation, which will be required to process them for the same purposes as above, in their capacity as autonomous Data Controllers or as Data Processors, appointed for this purpose pursuant to Art. 28 GDPR. Personal data will never be disseminated.

## 3. RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECT

In relation to the processing of such data, Data Subjects shall be entitled to exercise the rights provided for in Articles 15-22 GDPR, by making a request without formalities to the Data Protection Officer (DPO) of Autostrade per l'Italia S.p.A. at the following PEC address: dpo@pec.autostrade.it, as well as to lodge a complaint, pursuant to Article 57 letter f) GDPR, with the Italian Data Protection Authority, Piazza Venezia, 11, 00187 Rome (RM), to enforce such rights in relation to said data processing.
