## Privacy notice pursuant to articles 13 and 14 of European Regulation 2016/679

Pursuant to the current legislation on privacy (articles 13 and 14 of European Regulation 2016/679 - "GDPR"), this notice provides information on how Autostrade per l'Italia SpA processes the personal data Users provide in order to subscribe to our "Investor Relations Newsletter" and to receive updates on the Group's results and financial press releases, with merely informative content, directly to their e-mail inbox.

Subscription to this Newsletter, by completing the web form – published in the "Investor Relations" section of Autostrade per l'Italia SpA's website - with personal data and e-mail address, is necessary to receive financial information and updates from Autostrade per l'Italia SpA completely free of charge.

### 1. DATA CONTROLLER

Autostrade per l'Italia SpA, with its registered office at via A. Bergamini, 50 - 00159 Rome.

## 2. CATEGORIES OF DATA PROCESSED

Personal data processed by Autostrade per l'Italia SpA includes "common" data (such as, for instance: personal information, e-mail addresses) provided by Users through the web form published in the "Investor Relations" section of Autostrade per l'Italia SpA's website for the purpose described below in paragraph 3.

### 3. PURPOSE AND LEGAL BASIS FOR THE PROCESSING

The common personal data, directly provided by Users when subscribing to the Newsletter, will be processed by Autostrade per l'Italia SpA for the sole purposes connected and/or functional to managing the subscription and sending the Newsletter.

The provision of personal data is optional and voluntary but is necessary to subscribe to the Newsletter service and to receive the Newsletter itself. The failure to provide the requested data or the provision of incomplete or incorrect information will mean that the User will be unable to subscribe for the service or to receive the Newsletter.

# 4. HOW THE DATA IS PROCESSED

Personal data is processed, in compliance with current regulations, in manual, digital or electronic form and strictly in connection with the purposes indicated in order to guarantee data security and confidentiality.

The Newsletter is sent to Users via the e-mail platform of the Data Controller's technology provider, as indicated in paragraph 6. The Data Controller has dedicated access to the platform and the personal data is stored on a server belonging to the provider located within the European Union.

### 5. DATA STORAGE TIMES

The data will be stored for the period of time necessary to fulfil the purposes for which it was collected in compliance with the minimisation principle pursuant to art. 5.1(c) of the GDPR and in any event until the User withdraws their consent for processing, unsubscribes from the Newsletter or explicitly requests the cancellation of the personal data. In exceptional cases, the Data Controller may continue to store personal

data in order to defend its rights in the event of a dispute brought by the User or at the request of the authorities.

### 6. DATA RECIPIENTS

Within Autostrade per l'Italia SpA's organisation, only the persons appointed and authorised to process the data by the Data Controller in relation to the aforementioned purposes may have access to the personal data provided.

The data may be made available to third parties (such as, the provider of the platform and the e-mail service, referred to in paragraph 4), so as to process the information for the same purposes referred to in paragraph 3. These persons are, for this purpose, appointed as "Data Processors" pursuant to art. 28 of the GDPR. The full list of persons appointed as Data Processors is available from the DPO. Under no circumstances will personal data be made public.

## 7. TRANSFER OF DATA OUTSIDE THE EUROPEAN UNION

Personal data is not transferred outside the European Union. In any event, should a transfer of data to countries outside the European Union occur, the Data Controller will continue to guarantee that an adequacy decision has been obtained from the European Commission, or that appropriate data protection provisions are agreed with any third-party recipients. In any event, the data will be processed in the interests of the data subject and on the basis of any related consent.

## 8. DATA SUBJECTS' RIGHTS

Articles 15-22 of the GDPR give data subjects the possibility to exercise specific rights. More specifically, the Data Controller must grant data subjects the right to access, amend, erase, place restrictions on the processing of the data, withdraw their consent or to transfer any data.

Data subjects also have the right to object to the processing of their data. In the event that such a right is exercised, the Data Controller reserves the right not to proceed with fulfilment of the request, and to therefore to continue processing the data, if there are compelling legitimate grounds for the processing that override the interests, rights and freedoms of the data subject.

The above rights may be exercised by sending a request, without formalities, to the Data Protection Officer (DPO) at the following certified e-mail address: dpo@pec.autostrade.it. Requests may also be made by using one of the specific forms made available by the Data Controller on the website at <a href="www.autostrade.it">www.autostrade.it</a>.

The data subject may also lodge a complaint with the Data Protection Authority pursuant to art. 57(f) of the GDPR.
